Note:

- 1. NTA Scores are normalized scores across multi-session papers and are based on the relative performance of all those who appeared for the examination in one session. The marks obtained are transformed into a scale ranging from 100 to 0 for each session of examinees.
- 2. The NTA Score indicates the percentage of candidates who have scored EQUAL TO OR BELOW (same or lower raw scores) that particular candidate in that session.
- 3. The Percentile scores of a Candidate have been calculated as follows:

100 × Number of candidates who appeared in the 'Session' with a raw score EQUAL TO OR LESS than the candidate
The total number of candidates who appeared in the 'Session'

- 4. The NTA Score of the Total is NOT an aggregate or average of the NTA Score of individual subjects.
- 5. NTA scores are not the same as the percentage of marks obtained.
- 6. Candidate's particulars including Category and Person with Disability (PwD) have been indicated as mentioned by the candidate in the online Application Form.
