Step 1: Login to Oracle Website and search for Downloads for JDeveloper 11g (11.1.1.6.0).

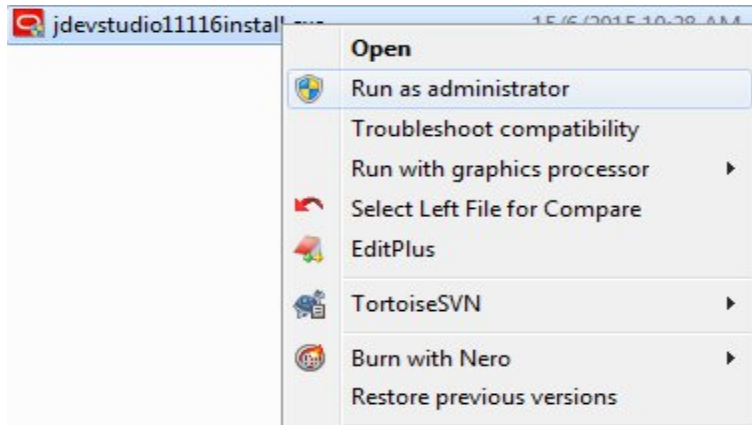
In the below page click on “[Download File](#)” command button.

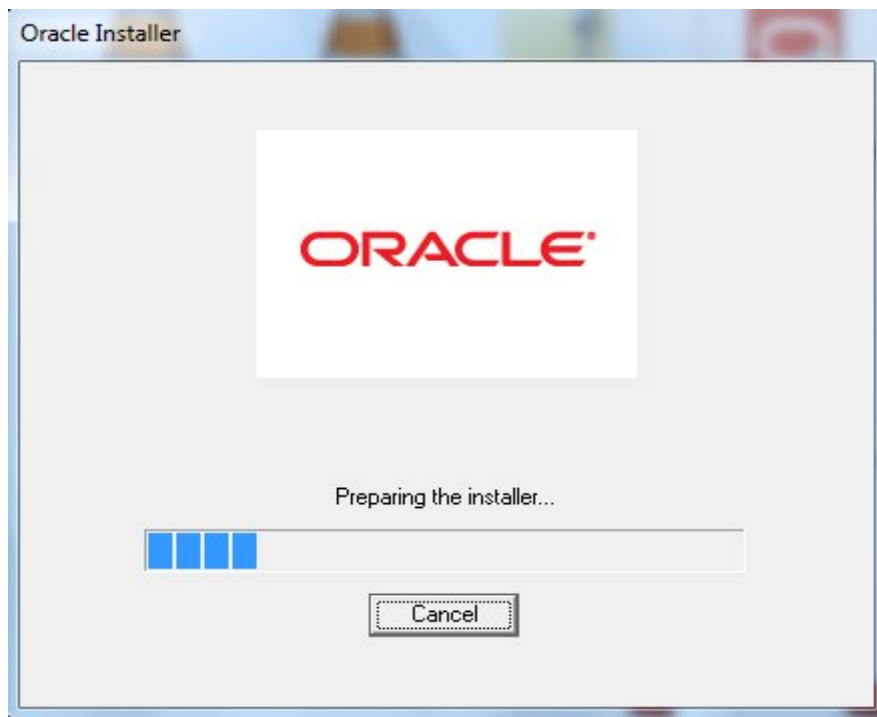
Step 2: An exe file named with “jdevstudio11116install.exe” will be downloaded into our local folder.

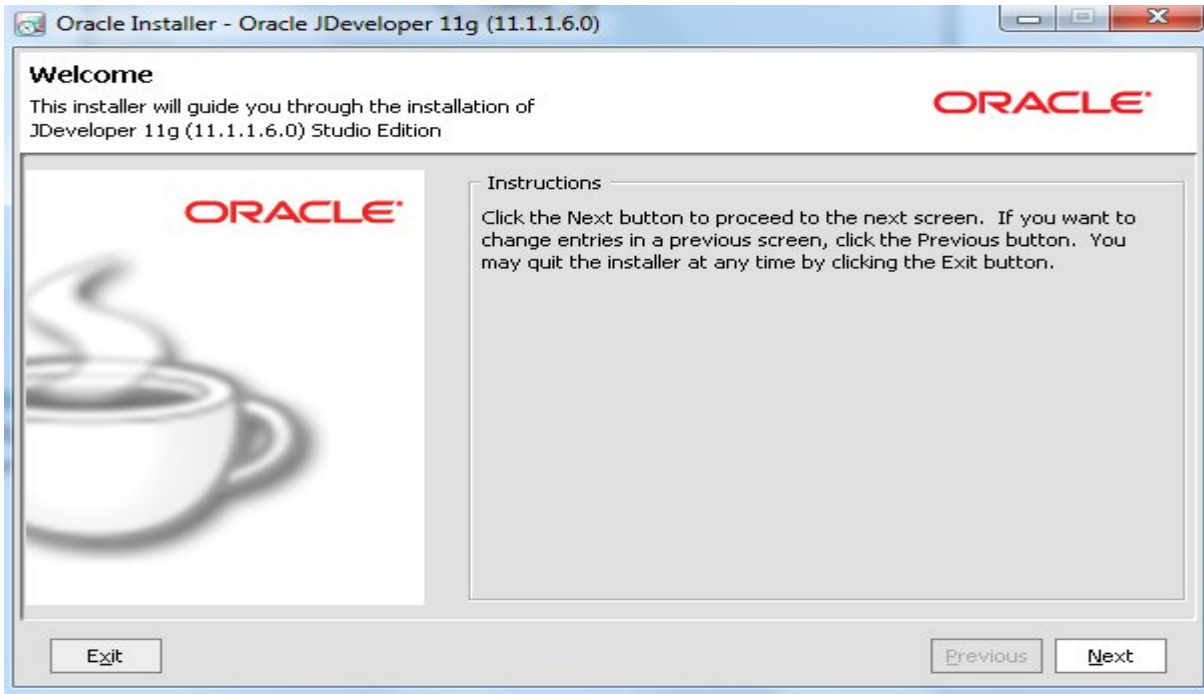
Step 3: Double Click or Right Click and Run as Administrator on the Jdeveloper exe file.



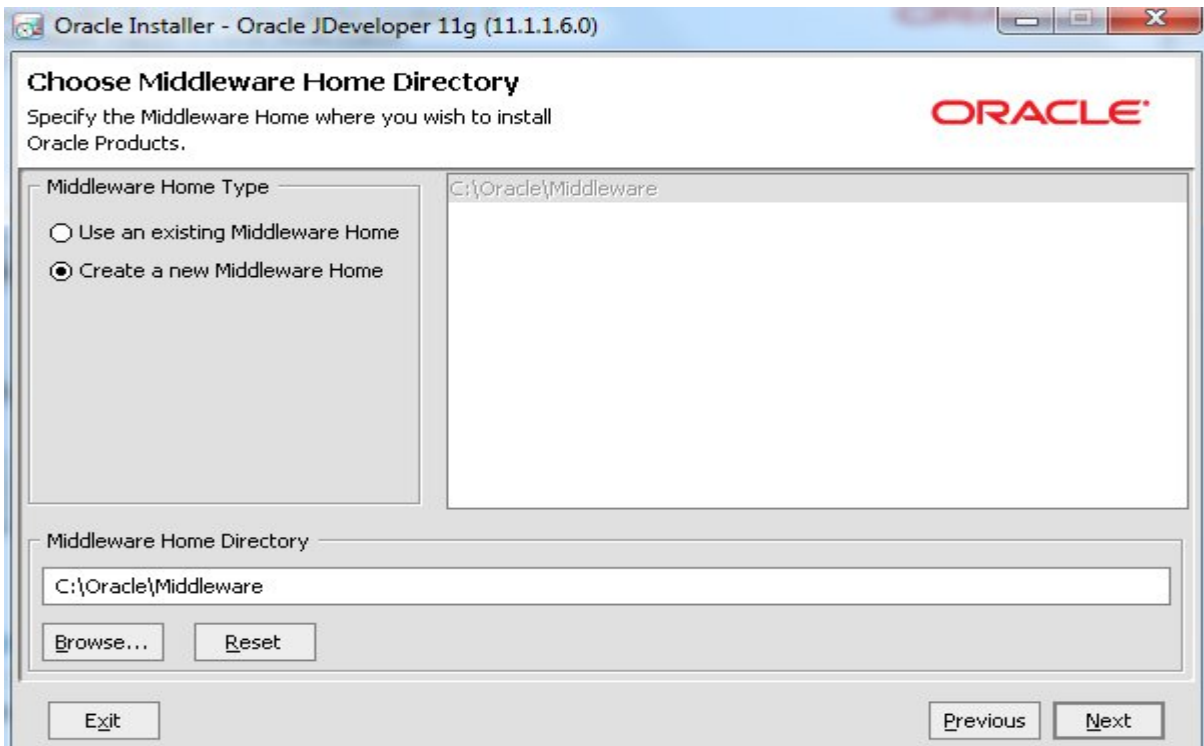
Step 4: Click on Yes button to prepare the Installer.



Step 5: Click on “Next” button to proceed the installation.



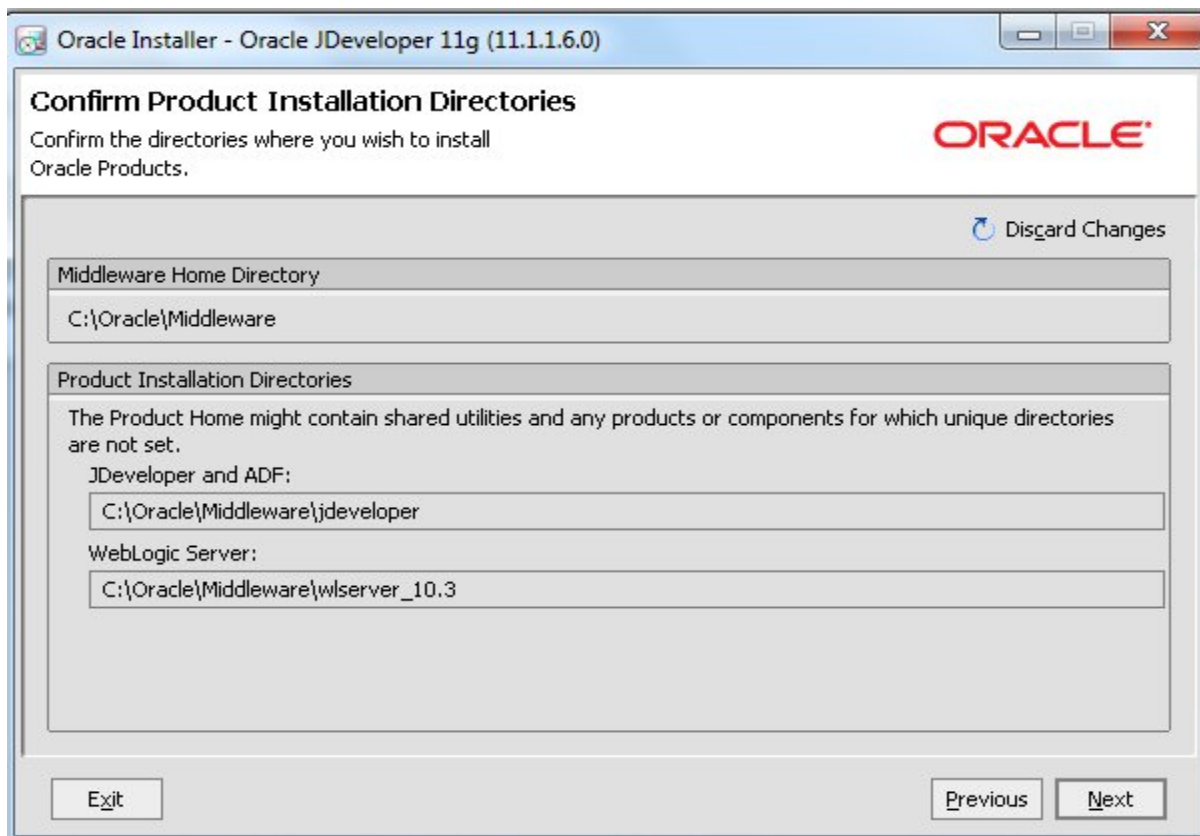
Step 6: Configure the ADF Home directory and Click on “Next” button.



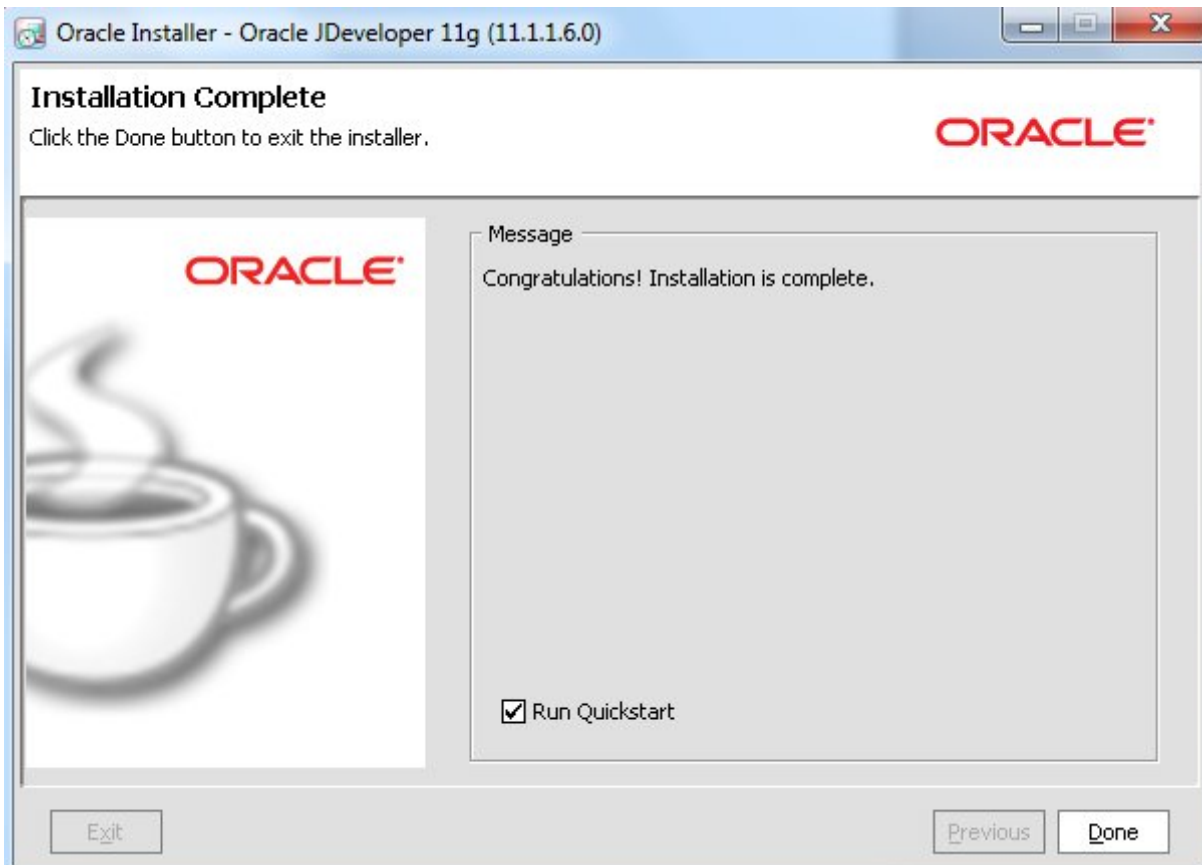
Step 7: Chose Complete option (default one) and Click on “Next” button.



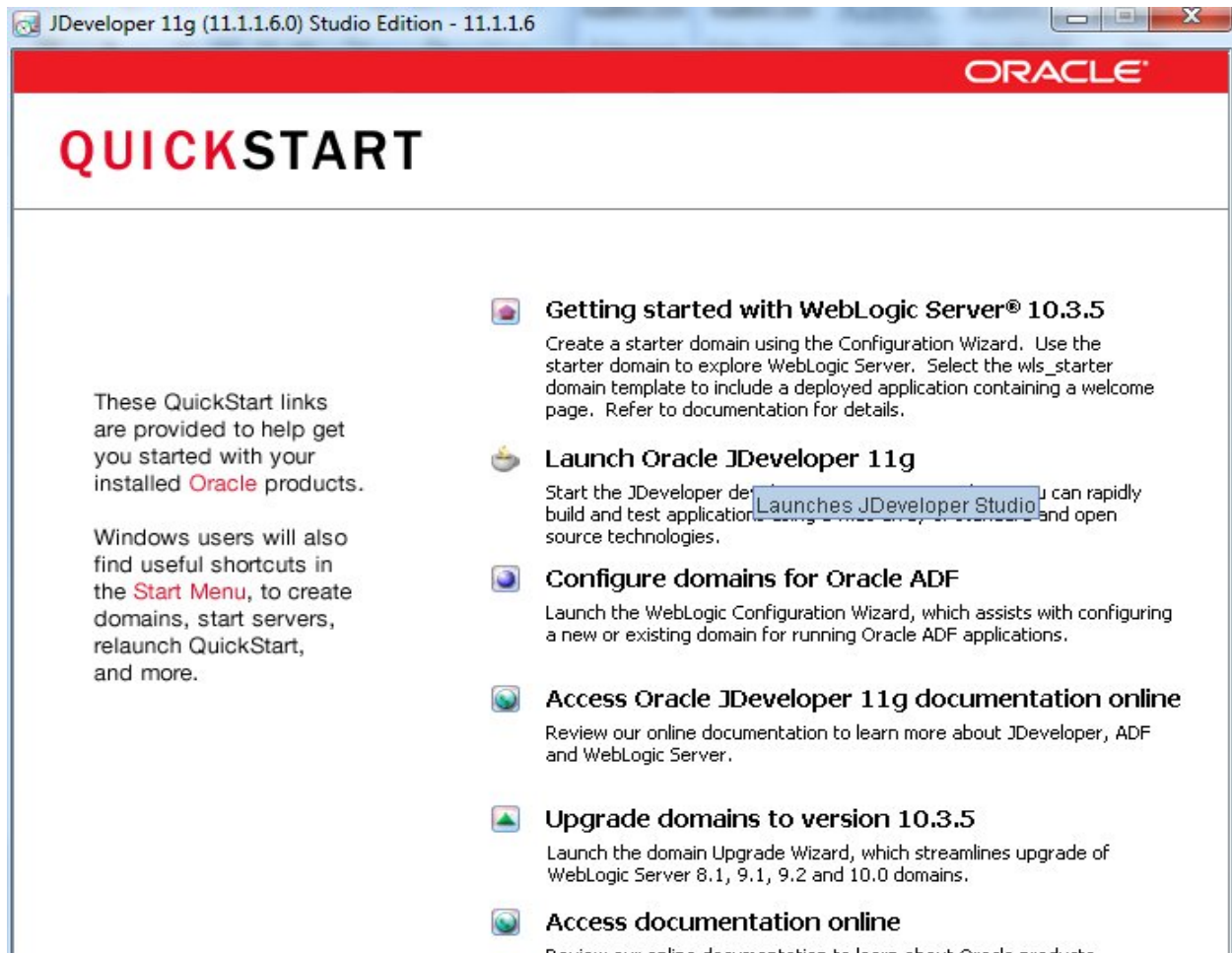
Step 8: After confirming the below configurations Click on “Next” button.
