Pre Application Procedure

- 1. Short listing of Universities.
- 2. Online application.
- 3. Get. GRE / GMAT & TOFEL scores in hand.
- 4. Collect the documents:

Mark sheet, Transcripts, Certificate from H.S.C., up to graduation, financial documents from the sponsor.

- 5. Preparation of SOP & Recos
 - 3 (SOP) + 5 (RECOS) MBA Programmes.
 - 1 (SOP) + 3 (RECOS) MS Programmes
- 6. Applying to universities / Colleges with all the documents, application fees.
- 7. Wait for I-20.
- 8. After receiving I-20, prepare for Visa File / Visa Interviews.
- 9. Visa-Guidance Mock Visa Interviews are conducted.
- 10. Please make sure to submit all the original documents along with one set Xerox. The original set will be returned to you after verifications.
- 11. For further clarity please take appointment to meet our counselor any day.

Visa Guidance

- All students leaving the country to study abroad will need a student visa. To get your documents
 in order, we will issue you a VISA checklist that enables you to prepare all the paper work
 required for the VISA interview. Once these documents are ready, we will then check them.
- Later we will take you for a Mock VISA interview before your main interview.
- Outright proof of liquid cash through bank statement.
- Showing all the money required for all the years by liquid ash will boost the chances of your getting a VISA.
- You should present your project report properly arranged.
- Fill your application at your own consulate at a nominal fee submitting your I-20 form issued by the University.
