


This booklet will help you to learn French vocabulary if you use it properly.

Step 1. Learn
Step 2. Cover
Step 3. Say and write
Step 4. Check



Remember it is important to **say** and **write** new words as well as just reading them.
Perhaps someone at home could test you or you could work with a friend and test each other.

When you are sure you know a word or phrase, (did you manage to get it correct perhaps three times?) put a tick next to the word or phrase so that you know how well you are doing.
