- 3. The NTA scores of a Candidate have been calculated as follows:

(100* Number of candidates appeared in the "session" with raw score EQUAL TO OR LESS than the candidate) ÷ (Total number

of candidates appeared in the "session").

- 4. The NTA Score of the Total is NOT an aggregate or average of the NTA Score of an individual subject.
- 5. The candidate's particulars including Category and Person with Disability (PwD) have been indicated as mentioned by the candidate in the online Application Form.
- 6. After the JEE (MAIN) 2024 Session 2, the ranks of the candidates will be released taking into consideration the best of the two NTA Scores.
- 7. RL means 'Result Later'.
- 8. This electronically generated Score Card is the official Score Card published by the NTA.
- 9. The National Testing Agency has taken due care while uploading the Score Card. However, in case of any inadvertent error, the NTA reserves the right to rectify the same at a later stage.
