
Implementing SAP Workflow

What is Workflow?

- A mechanism that automates business processes.
 - Ensures adherence to that process
 - Transparency of users and process
 - Process data available at your finger tips
 - Reporting exposes bottlenecks and inefficiencies

Workflow Components



Triggering Mechanisms

- Events (publish and subscribe mechanism)
 - Status Management
 - Change Documents
 - User Exits and others
- Manual Triggering
 - Various Function Modules

Implementation Tips

- Use Check Function Modules\Start Conditions
- Use caching algorithms when writing custom BOR methods
- Don't create superfluous container elements
- Objects not simple variables
