Required documents

The foremost thing that you need for immigration is the 67 points out of 100 in the **Canada PR Points system**. This point is obtained by some calculations made on the date of birth, work experience, language skills, qualification, and adaptability.

Processing time for the Canada PR visa

There cannot be a definitive period for Canada but it can be stated that the approval of the visa depends on variegated factors that can contribute in late and early processing of the visa. However, the general process time takes from 4 to 6 months. For an easy process, it is important to have the right program like the Canada Express Entry Program.
