Exam structure - I

- Four papers (all papers have same weightage of 25%)
- Paper 1 – (Listening): 45 minutes, 45 marks
- Paper 2 – (Reading): 1 hour, 45 marks
- Paper 3 – (Speaking): 15 minutes, 100 marks
- Paper 4 – (Writing): 1 hour, 50 marks

Exam structure – II

(Paper-1: Listening)

- Three sections (All recordings will be played twice)
- Section 1 – 1st exercise - MCQs, 2nd exercise – MCQs and fill in the blanks
- Section 2 – 1st exercise – Choose correct statements, 2nd exercise (1st part) – Write correct words replacing wrong words, 2nd exercise (2nd part) – Answer the questions.
- Section 3 – 1st exercise – MCQs, 2nd exercise - Answer the questions.

Exam structure – III

(Paper-2: Reading)

- Three sections
- Section 1 – Exercise 1,2,3 – MCQs
- Section 2 – Exercise 1 – choose correct words, Exercise 2 – Answer the questions
- Section 3 – Exercise 1 – True/False and correct wrong sentences, Exercise 2 – Answer the questions

Exam structure – IV

(Paper-3: Speaking)

- Three parts
- 1st part – Two role plays with the examiner
- 2nd part – A topic presentation
- 3rd part – A general conversation on minimum three sub-topics
- Students need to use past and future tenses and conjugations correctly to get 80% in this paper.

Exam structure – V

(Paper-4: Writing)

- Two sections
- 1st Section – 1st question – Write 8 words based on one sub-topic, 2nd question – Write an essay between 80 to 90 words based on three or four verbal stimuli.
- 2nd Section – Write an essay/article/email/etc. between 130 to 140 words based on four or five verbal stimuli.
