

International Olympiads

General Information

The International Olympiad (IO) programme follows a five stage process.

Stage one National Standard Examinations (NSEs) in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Astronomy, Junior Science organized by IAPT.

All the subsequent stages are conducted by Homi Bhabha Center for Science Education (HBCSE), Mumbai. (www.hbcse.tifr.res.in)

Stage two is the Indian National Olympiad (INO) examinations. The eligible students from stage one can participate in INO in respective subjects.

Stage three is the Orientation Cum Selection Camps (OCSC). For these camps, about 35 students in each subject will be selected from INO on performance basis

Stage four These students will have a Pre Departure Training (PDT) for two weeks.

Stage five Participation in International Olympiad (IO) of the selected students.
