

## **International Olympiads**

## **General Information**

The International Olympiad (IO) programme follows a five stage process.

**Stage one** National Standard Examinations (NSEs) in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Astronomy, Junior Science organized by IAPT.

All the subsequent stages are conducted by Homi Bhabha Center for Science Education (HBCSE), Mumbai.( www.hbcse.tifr.res.in )

**Stage two** is the Indian National Olympiad (INO) examinations. The eligible students from stage one can participate in INO in respective subjects.

**Stage three** is the Orientation Cum Selection Camps (OCSC). For these camps, about 35 students in each subject will be selected from INO on performance basis

**Stage four** These students will have a Pre Departure Training (PDT) for two weeks.

**Stage five** Participation in International Olympiad (IO) of the selected students.
