The IWRT has implemented a Conservation Industry Advisory Board to establish education and training needs for the sector, which will help guide the development of new qualifications, short learning programmes and the development of new education and training methodologies into the future.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

The Studying wildlife behavior, predicting or anticipating wildlife action. Knowledge of distribution and behavior, anticipation of moments, approaching wildlife.

TARGET GROUP AND SEAT

The diploma Course is designed for in-service Range Photographer In Forest Department sectors of the Government, NGO's, and private organizations with interests in wildlife conservation and management.

The seats are limited to thirty (30) and allotment would be done on first cum first serve basis.

ELIGIBILITY

A wildlife photographer who has cleared a 10th/12th standard and a diploma/certificate course in professional photography or wildlife photography is well qualified to become a wildlife photographer. And there is no age limit for this profession.

DURATION

The duration of the course is Six months covering one academic session.

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ATTENDANCE

Participation in all components of the course, tours, excursions, lectures, practicals, examinations, group discussions and symposia etc are compulsory.

COURSE CONTENTS

The broad outline of the course structure includes the following modules:

- a. Basic Photography
- b. Introduction to wildlife photography
- c. To understand animal behavior

ASSESSMENT AND COURSE AWARDS

Assessment is an integral part of the learning process and will be based on module wise performance of officer trainees both in class room and during field exercise. Evaluation will also include group discussion, assignments, written and oral tests.

Traning Cost

This is the paid course for all the participants. Course fee for Indian trainees is INR 60000/-.

The course fee also included books/study materials. The sponsoring agencies are advised to provide insurance for sponsored candidates comprehensively for any medical treatment for the duration of the training.

Excluded : The course fee not include local traveling, camping, field gear/stationery etc.

A bank draft / Cheque of the above amount should be sent in the favour of the Kaimur Wildlife Foundation payable at Bhabua at the time of admission by the sponsored candidate. The course can also be remitted by bank transfer. Bank details can be obtained from the Course Director.
