# IELTS General

**Purpose:** Primarily for those planning to undertake higher education or professional registration in an English-speaking environment.

**Reading:** In the Academic module, the reading passages are more academically oriented, with topics related to academic subjects.

**Writing Task 1:** Involves describing visual information such as graphs, charts, and diagrams.

**Writing Task 2:** Requires candidates to write an essay in response to a point of view, argument, or problem.

**Listening and Speaking:** The content is more academically focused, with lectures and discussions related to university life.



**Purpose:** Geared towards those migrating to English-speaking countries for secondary education, work experience, or training programs.

**Reading:** The passages in the General Training module are related to everyday life, work, and general topics.

**Writing Task 1:** Involves letter writing. Candidates are asked to write a letter requesting information or explaining a situation.

**Writing Task 2:** Requires candidates to write an essay in response to a point of view, argument, or problem. The topics are more related to general issues.

**Listening and Speaking:** The content is related to everyday social situations and workplace scenarios.

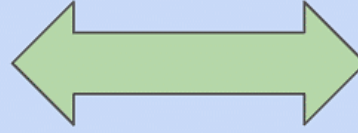
