3. Tools and Materials for Pattern Making, Pattern Drafting

- Familiarize yourself with essential tools, such as measuring tapes, rulers, drafting paper, and other supplies.
- Understand different fabric types and their properties.
- Draft basic patterns using the measurements, creating templates for components like the front, back, sleeves, and neckline.
- Incorporate seam allowances, darts, and notches into the pattern for accurate construction.

4. Marking, Preparing, and Cutting the Fabric

- Lay out the fabric and position the pattern pieces correctly, ensuring the grainline is followed for a proper drape and fit.
- Transfer essential markings from the pattern to the fabric, including darts, notches, and seam lines.
- Cut the fabric accurately and prepare necessary components such as interfacing, lining, and trims.

5. Construction and Finishing Techniques

- Sew the individual parts of the blouse, following the pattern's guidelines.
- Assemble the prepared pieces, ensuring a seamless fit.

• Press and test the fit, making any necessary adjustments to achieve the desired finish.
