

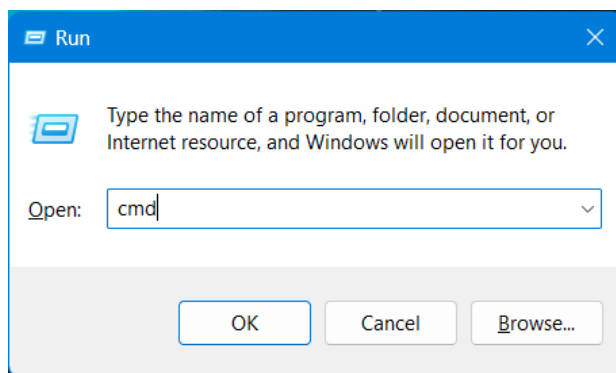
CMD Commands for Daily use

Topic – How to Open Command prompt.

Step 1 – Press Win+R to open Run DIALOGUE BOX

Step 2 – Type 'cmd' or 'CMD' to open Run DIALOGUE BOX.

**** Note – If you type 'cmd.exe – it opens PowerShell – an advanced version of Command prompt**



Commands List

1. **Ipconfig** – To know about your Device IP Address, network configuration and its DHCP & DNS settings.
2. **Ping** – to check your network connection to any remote server.
Eg . Ping 8.8.8.8 for Google DNS or
Eg . ping www.google.co.in
3. **Cls** – clear the current CMD screen.
4. **Systeminfo** – to get detailed information about your system – like RAM, PROCESSOR, OS INSTALLED VERSION, and so on.
5. **Shutdown / s** – to shut down your system
6. **CD** – to change directory – cd [path]
** you can also CD Command to know in which directory you are currently working
Simply type – cd
