Commands List

- 1. **Ipconfig** To know about your Device IP Address, network configuration and its DHCP & DNS settings.
- 2. **Ping** to check your network connection to any remote server.
  - Eg . Ping 8.8.8.8 for Google DNS or Eg . ping www.google.co.in
- 3. **Cls** clear the current CMD screen.
- 4. **Systeminfo** to get detailed information about your system like RAM, PROCESSOR, OS INSTALLED VERSION, and so on.
- 5. Shutdown / s to shut down your system
- 6. CD to change directory cd [path]
  \*\* you can also CD Command to know in which directory you are currently working Simply type – cd
