1. "It's small/big." - used to describe the size of an object.
 2. "It's heavy/light." - used to describe the weight of an object.
 3. "It's hard/soft." - used to describe the texture or firmness of an object.
 4. "It's smooth/rough." - used to describe the texture or surface of an object.
 5. "It's round/square/rectangular." - used to describe the shape of an object.
 6. "It's sharp/dull." - used to describe the edge or point of an object.
 7. "It's shiny/dull." - used to describe the appearance of an object.
 8. "It's transparent/opaque." - used to describe the ability of an object to allow light to pass through.
 9. "It's new/old." - used to describe the age or condition of an object.
 10. "It's useful/useless." - used to describe the usefulness or value of an object.
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1. "It has intricate details." - used to describe an object that has a lot of small, complex details.
 2. "It's aesthetically pleasing." - used to describe an object that is visually attractive or beautiful.
 3. "It's multifunctional." - used to describe an object that can serve multiple purposes or functions.
 4. "It has ergonomic design." - used to describe an object that is designed for optimal comfort and efficiency of use.
 5. "It has a sleek/modern design." - used to describe an object that has a streamlined and contemporary appearance.
 6. "It's made of high-quality materials." - used to describe an object that is crafted from durable and long-lasting materials.
 7. "It's eco-friendly/sustainable." - used to describe an object that has been manufactured in an environmentally conscious way.
 8. "It's one-of-a-kind." - used to describe an object that is unique and cannot be found elsewhere.
 9. "It's a collector's item." - used to describe an object that is rare and valuable for collectors.
