Topics: Role of audio interfaces, DAWs, setting up Logic Pro

Activities: Configuring audio interfaces

Week 4: Acoustics & Monitoring

Topics: Room acoustics, monitor speaker placement, headphone vs. monitor mixing

Activities: Analyzing room acoustics

Week 6: MIDI Recording & Editing

Activities: Recording and editing MIDI

Week 7: Audio Recording & Editing

Topics: Recording audio, comping and editing

Activities: Recording and editing audio tracks

Week 8: Apple Loops & Virtual Instruments

Topics: Apple Loops, Logic's virtual instruments

Activities: Create a short composition
