A1 – Beginner Level

Goal: Understand and use familiar everyday expressions and basic phrases.

What You'll Learn:

- Italian Alphabet & Pronunciation
- Numbers, Days, Months, Seasons
- Greetings, Self-introduction, Nationalities
- Definite & Indefinite Articles (il, lo, la, un, una)
- Basic Sentence Structure (SVO)
- Present Tense Verbs (Essere, Avere, regular -are, -ere, -ire)
- Gender & Singular/Plural of Nouns
- Talking about likes/dislikes (piacere)
- Basic Vocabulary (family, food, school, colors, objects)
- Simple dialogues: at the café, supermarket, or hotel
- Forming questions & negation


 **Can do:** Talk about yourself, family, describe people, give and receive simple info.

A2 – Elementary Level

Goal: Understand frequently used expressions in common situations.

What You'll Learn:

- Reflexive Verbs & Daily Routines
- Modal Verbs (volere, potere, dovere)
- Telling Time, Date, and Weather
- Prepositions (di, a, da, in, con, su, per, tra/fra)
- Possessive Adjectives (mio, tua, nostro...)
- Past Tense: Passato Prossimo (with avere & essere)
- Comparatives & Superlatives
- Direct/Indirect Object Pronouns (lo, la, gli, le...)
- Vocabulary expansion: travel, directions, health
- Short letters, emails, and polite requests


 **Can do:** Talk about past events, express needs, describe routines and places, ask for help, write short messages.

B1 – Intermediate Level

Goal: Deal with most situations likely to arise while traveling, and discuss familiar topics.

What You'll Learn:

- Imperfetto (used to...), Trapassato Prossimo (past perfect)
- Future Tense (Futuro Semplice)
- Conditional Tense (I would...)
- Subjunctive (Congiuntivo Presente) – intro
- Formal and Informal language
- Reported Speech (discorso indiretto – intro)
- Expressing opinions, doubts, hopes
- Hypothetical situations (periodo ipotetico – tipo 1)
- Writing paragraphs, letters, and summaries
- Vocabulary: work, hobbies, media, environment


 **Can do:** Narrate, describe events in different tenses, give opinions, participate in conversations and interviews.

B2 – Upper Intermediate Level






Goal: Interact with fluency and spontaneity with native speakers.

What You'll Learn:

- Subjunctive Tenses (Present, Imperfetto, Past) in depth
- Complex sentence structures (che, perché, affinché...)
- Hypothetical Clauses (2nd & 3rd type)
- Gerund and Past Participle constructions
- Passive Voice
- Idiomatic Expressions and Formal Phrases
- Advanced Reading & Listening Comprehension
- Argumentative Writing & Speaking
- Practice with News, Podcasts, Films, and Authentic Texts

 **Can do:** Debate, negotiate, express complex ideas, write reports or emails, understand TV/radio, and read literature.

Format of the Course:

-  **Frequency:** 1–2 sessions per week
-  **Duration:** 60–90 minutes per session
-  **Method:** Live Zoom/Google Meet + PDFs + Practice Sheets + Quizzes + Homework
-  **Materials:** Customized worksheets, audio support, conversation tasks, real-life scenarios
-  **Preparation for Exams:** CILS / CELI (optional)
