- **Summarizing for Precision:** You are great at catching specific details, but we will practice summarizing information more concisely. This means picking out only the most important points to give a clear, brief overview. 🗨️
- **Modal Verbs (Shall vs. Could):** You need more practice distinguishing between these two words for suggestions and possibilities.

- **Summary Sprints:** After reading a text or watching a clip, have Assem try to summarize the "big idea" in just one or two sentences to build precision. 🗨️
- **Tense Awareness:** Practice talking about a past event and a future plan back-to-back to build agility in switching between past and future tenses.
- **Roleplay Suggestions:** Practice using "Shall" and "Could" in different scenarios to feel more comfortable with their subtle differences in tone. 🗣️
