CCTV Monitoring

Understanding ID verification, gate passes, and access badges shows you can protect premises effectively.



Emergency Response

Knowledge of fire safety, medical emergencies, and incident reporting proves you can handle critical situations professionally.

Why should we hire you? What makes you different from other candidates applying for this position?

How do you improve yourself? Are you willing to learn new skills and follow company discipline?

These questions assess your long-term potential, work ethic, and cultural fit. Show employers you're committed to growth and professional development in the security industry.

Constructive criticism helps both participants improve

- 📌 **Trainer Tip:** Conduct mock interviews in a quiet, professional setting. Use a timer to keep sessions realistic. Encourage participants to dress professionally to simulate actual interview conditions.

Mock Interview – Set 1 (Basic Questions)

1

Interviewer Preparation

Review questions in advance, maintain professional demeanor, take notes on candidate responses, ask follow-up questions naturally

2

Candidate Preparation

Practice your introduction, research the company, prepare specific examples, dress professionally, bring copies of documents

3

Setting the Scene

Start with greetings and small talk, create comfortable atmosphere, maintain eye contact, listen actively to answers

Question 1: Tell Me About Yourself

Interviewer's Question

English: Tell me about yourself

Bangla: নিজের সম্পর্কে বলুন

Candidate's Answer

English Response:

"My name is Krishna Mandal. I have 5 years of experience in security. I am skilled in CCTV monitoring, access control, and incident handling. I work in Bangalore."

Bangla Response:

"আমার নাম কৃষ্ণ মন্ডল। আমার ৫ বছরের নিরাপত্তা কাজের অভিজ্ঞতা আছে। আমি CCTV মনিটরিং, অ্যাক্সেস কন্ট্রোল এবং ইনসিডেন্ট হ্যান্ডলিং-এ দক্ষ। আমি ব্যাঙ্গালোরে কাজ করি।"

Key Points: This is typically the first question. Structure your answer: name → experience → key skills → current position. Keep it 30-45 seconds. Highlight relevant security experience and certifications.

Question 2: Why Should We Hire You?

Interviewer's Question

English: Why should we hire you?

Bangla: আমরা আপনাকে কেন নিয়োগ করব?

Candidate's Answer

English Response:

"I am disciplined, alert, and responsible. I follow rules and handle situations calmly."

Bangla Response:

"আমি শৃঙ্খলাবদ্ধ, সতর্ক এবং দায়িত্বশীল। আমি নিয়ম মেনে চলি এবং শান্তভাবে পরিস্থিতি সামাল দিই।"

Discipline, alertness, responsibility, and calmness under pressure

Connect to Job Needs

Explain how your traits match security requirements

Keep It Concise

30 seconds maximum - focus on strongest selling points
