

Guitar Course Structure

Phase 1 — Guitar Basics & Foundation

Perfect for complete beginners.

In this phase, students will learn:

- Correct way to hold the guitar comfortably
- Understanding frets and fretboard basics
- Names of all guitar strings
- Finger positioning and hand coordination
- Basic rhythm understanding
- Simple exercises to improve finger movement

Goal

Build a strong and comfortable foundation before playing songs.

Phase 2 — First Chord Set + Song Playing

This is where students start actually enjoying the guitar.

Students will learn these 4 essential chords:

- A Minor (Am)
- F Major (F)
- C Major (C)
- G Major (G)

Also included:

- Beginner-friendly strumming pattern
- Smooth chord switching practice
- Rhythm control
- Singing while playing basics

Goal

Play and sing a large number of popular songs using only these chords.

Phase 3 — Advanced Beginner Chord Set

After mastering the first set, students move to the next important level.

Students will learn:

- Another practical set of 4 commonly used chords
- New strumming variations
- Better rhythm flow
- Faster chord transitions
- More song combinations

Goal

Increase song-playing ability and confidence while sounding more professional.

Phase 4 — Fingerstyle & Impressive Playing Techniques

This phase focuses on making the guitar sound beautiful and expressive.

Students will learn:

- Beginner-friendly fingerstyle techniques
- Melody playing with chords
- Popular English and Hindi fingerstyle songs
- Soft cinematic playing style
- Performance-focused practice

Goal

Play fingerstyle songs that sound impressive and emotionally engaging.

Teaching Style

- Beginner friendly
- Practical learning approach
- Less theory, more playing
- Focus on confidence and enjoyment
- Learn songs as early as possible
