What You'll Need

- A quiet, comfortable space with minimal distractions.
- A stable high-speed internet connection.
- A notebook or writing pad and a pen/pencil for exercises and reflections.
- A tarot deck (any standard Rider–Waite–Smith based deck is recommended for beginners, but any deck you connect with is welcome).
- A charged device (computer, tablet, or smartphone) with audio enabled.
- An open mind, curiosity, and a willingness to practise regularly.

How to Get the Best Results

- Attend each lesson with your tarot deck beside you.
- Complete the practical exercises after every class.
- Keep a tarot journal to record your interpretations and observations.
- Remember that tarot is a skill that develops through consistent practice.

This course focuses on learning tarot as a tool for insight, self-development, and responsible reading. Growth comes with practice—not memorisation alone.
