

Sample Lesson Plan

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Subject	English
Class	Grade 8
Topic	Active and Passive Voice
Duration	40 Minutes
Teaching Method	Interactive, Student-centred
Teaching Aids	Whiteboard, Marker, Textbook, Worksheet, PPT (optional)
Previous Knowledge	Students know Subject, Verb and Object.
Learning Objective	Students will understand, identify and convert Active and Passive Voice.

Learning Outcomes

- Differentiate between active and passive voice.
- Convert simple active sentences into passive voice.
- Recognise appropriate use of passive voice.

Lesson Procedure

Stage & Time	Teacher's Activity	Students' Activity	Resources	Assessment
Set Induction 5 min	Write: 'The police arrested the thief.' and 'The thief was arrested by the police.' Ask what changed.	Observe, compare, answer questions.	Board	Questioning
Presentation 15 min	Explain active/passive structures and demonstrate three examples.	Take notes, identify subject, verb and object.	Board/Textbook	Oral responses
Guided Practice 10 min	Guide students through sentence conversion.	Convert five sentences with support.	Worksheet	Teacher observation
Activity 5 min	Pair work: exchange notebooks and convert sentences.	Collaborate and discuss.	Worksheet	Peer review
Assessment 3 min	Ask three oral questions and one written	Respond individually.	Board	Quick check

	conversion.			
Homework 2 min	Write five active sentences and convert them.	Complete at home.	Notebook	Next class review

Differentiation

Provide simpler sentences to learners needing support. Challenge advanced learners with longer sentences.
