Expressing their dreams:

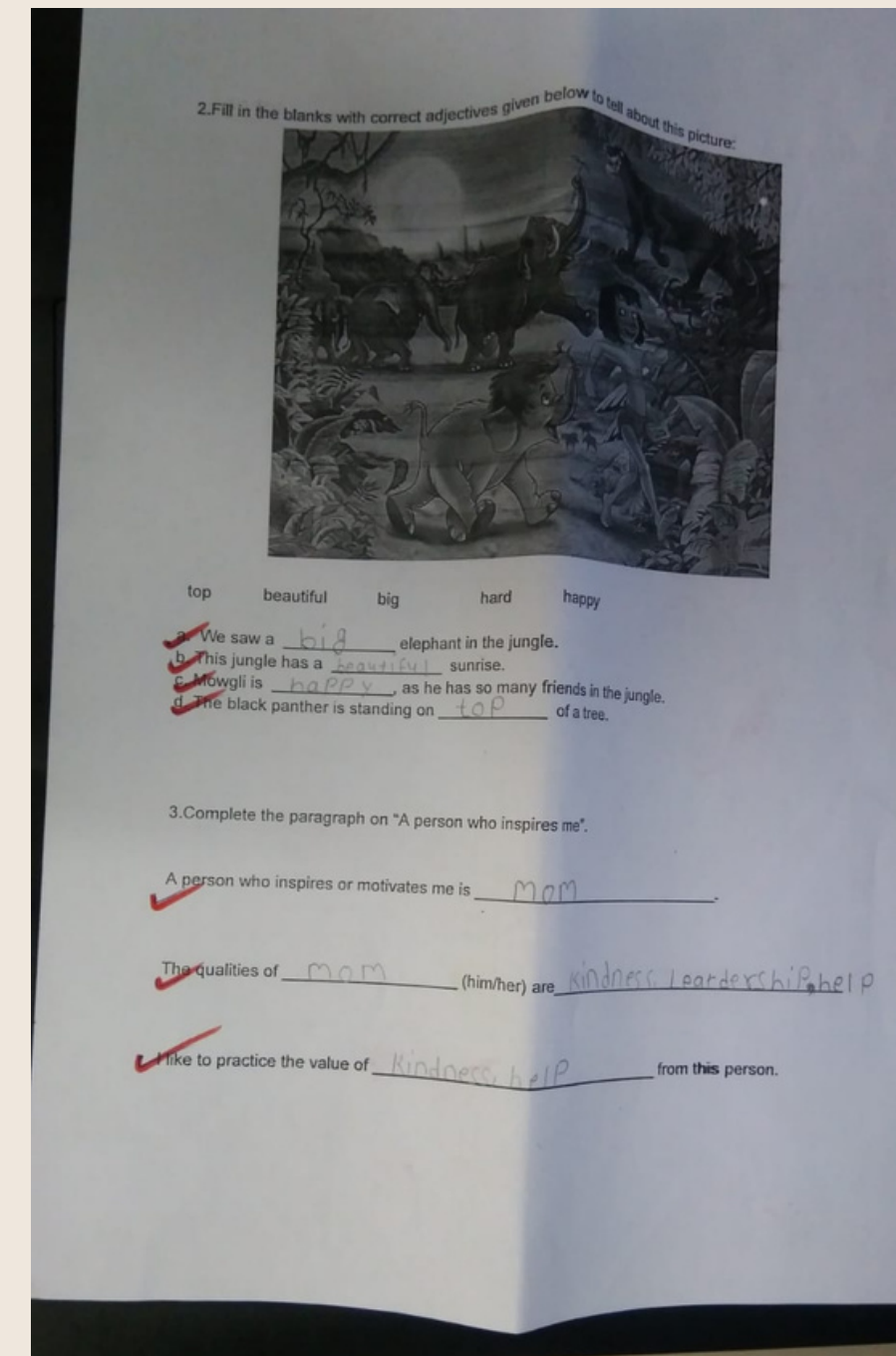
We started our class with introducing themselves with their dreams as the name of the class was the dream catchers. They were able to proudly express their dreams.

Expressing their fear:

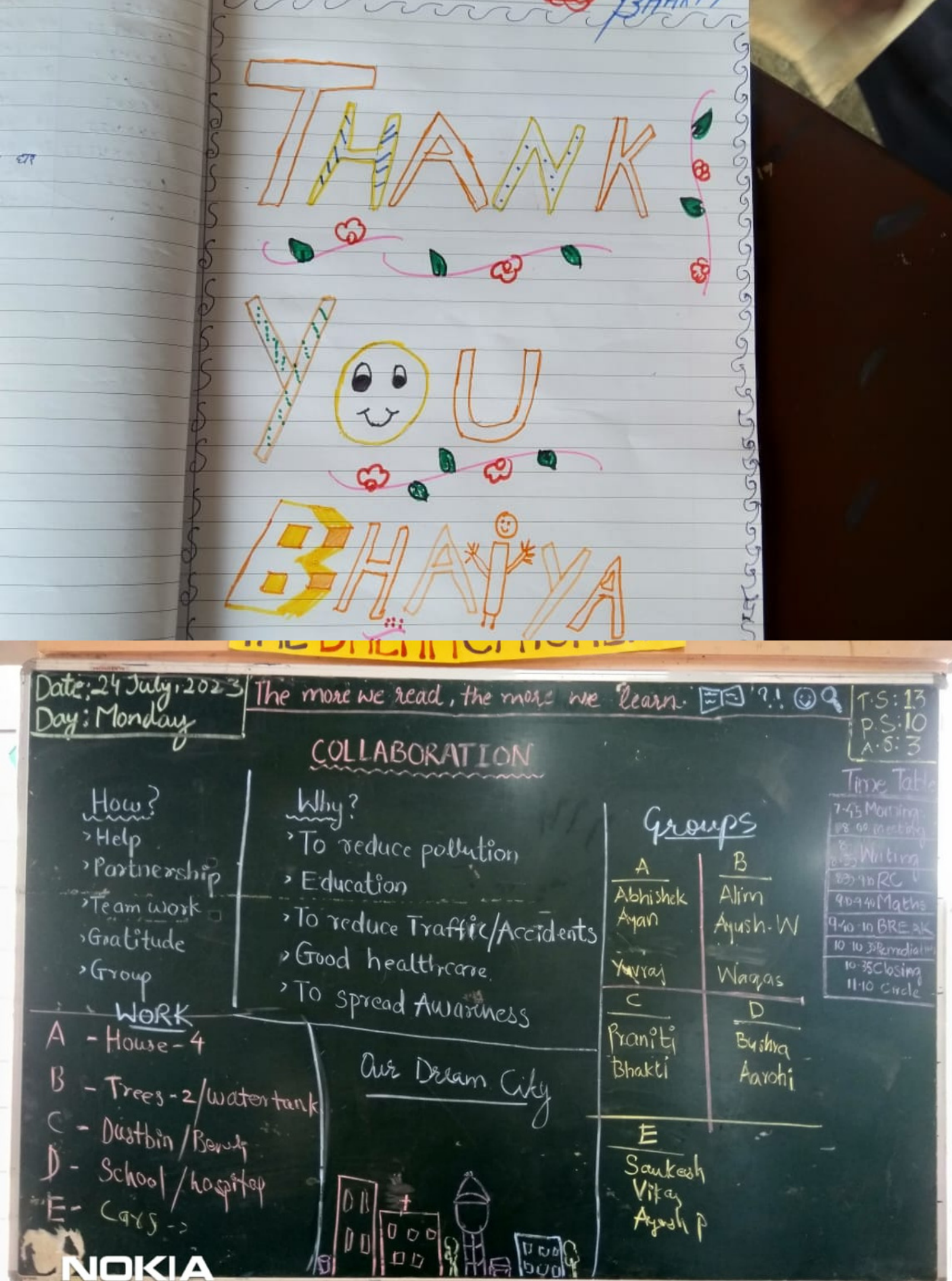
We were able to successfully provide a safe space where students openly voiced their concerns. Making sure that everyone's voice is heard genuinely made us connected.
