**Revolt**: a conflict in which one faction tries to wrest control from another **Rebellion**: Refusal to accept some authority, code or convention Archives: A depository containing historical records and documents Erstwhile: Belonging to some prior time (His erstwhile friend) Nuns: A woman religious Marred: Destroy or injure severely **Divulging**: that was meant to be kept a secret (divulge this file from the team) Quashed: Put down by force or intimidation Setback: hold or pull back to the later point of time Attorney: Lawyer Hind: Located at or near the back of an animal (hind lag) Irk: Irritate or vex Stiff: Not moving or operating freely **Erupts**: Start abruptly Jitter: A small irregular movement Intercepted: Secretly listen in on a communication channel (esp. a telephone) to get information Swanky: Imposingly fashionable and elegant **Alias** Renal Slams Sacks Graft Lingo= Jargon: the characteristic language of a particular community
