The **BASIC** safety management in current trend of regulations is to prevent human injury or loss of life, and to avoid damage to the environment and to property.

A safety management system is primarily proactive/predictive. It considers hazards and risks that impact the whole organization, as well as risk controls.

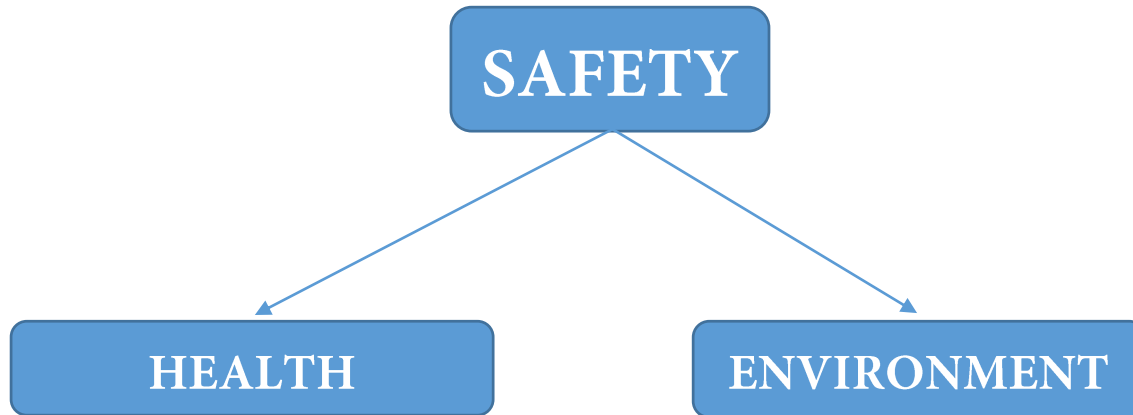
A top-down commitment from management and a personal commitment from all employees to achieve safety performance goals & an organizational culture that continuously strives to improve.

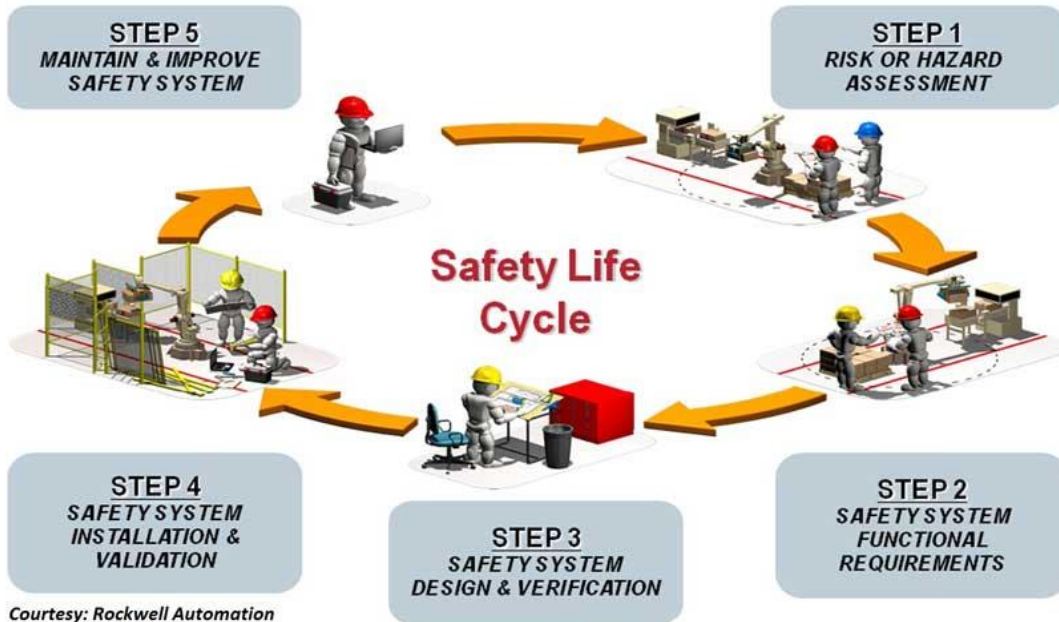
