Lesson Plan Activity: Debate

Skill in Focus: Speaking and Listening

Objective

To enable the learners to generate ideas, express them effectively; listen to others and present opinion.

Stage 1: Warming Up

Warm up the class by asking about their day. Reach to the topic by relating it with our daily life. Instructor may frame new questions for the learners to answer (related to the topic).

- 1. Difference between Online and Offline Classes.
- 2. What do you miss the most about Offline classes/School/College? Etc.

Stage 2: Introducing the Activity

Introduce the topic to the Learners and help them to choose their side for speaking. One learner will be in favour of opening Schools/Colleges and the other will be against.

Stage 3: Brainstorming

Allow 5 minutes time to learners for individual brainstorming. Learners could also mention the key points on a sheet of paper.

Stage 4: Running the Debate

Let the students present their opinion one by one. Encourage interaction between the learners. Ask them to counter question each other. Instructor can help the learners if they are unable to think of any points.

Stage 5: Closing the Debate

Close the debate by giving your views on the topic. Presenting a balanced idea is always better. Review speaking of the students.

Stage 6: Closing the Session

Close the session by giving your valuable feedback, and tips for improvement to both the students.
