Lesson Plan Activity: Observation & Thinking

Skill in Focus: Speaking and Interaction

Objective

To enable the students to speak in a situational conversation; to develop thinking, listening and speaking skills.

Activity

Let the students be the host of 'Mann ki Baat' for a day. Let them speak in the following situation – 'If you could speak for 10 minutes and be heard by everybody in the world, what would you say?'

Stage 1: Warming Up

An Introduction. Greet the learners and warm up by having them to speak about their day. Ask them to explain the Radio Programme 'Mann Ki Baat.'

Instructor can explain the same as:

Mann ki Baat is an Indian Radio Programme hosted by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in which he addresses the people of India on All India Radio, DD National & DD News.

Stage 2: Introducing and Running the Activity

Introduce the activity to the learners and let them speak about their thoughts/ideas. Offer equal talking time to the students. Help them in between if needed.

Stage 3: Closing the Activity

Close the activity by presenting your thoughts and by reviewing their ideas and speech.

Stage 4: Conclusion

Close the session by giving your feedback for each student and tips on improvement.
