

## How to Conjugate French Verbs: FUTURE TENSE

For the future tense in French the appropriate endings will be added to the infinitive of the verb. For verbs ending in “-RE”, remove the final “e” before adding the ending. There are several verbs that use an irregular stem instead of the infinitive. They are listed further below.

Remember that the near future can be conjugated as: ALLER + INFINITIVE = GOING TO \_\_\_\_\_

### -Future Tense Endings

je = <b>AI</b>	nous = <b>ONS</b>
tu = <b>AS</b>	vous = <b>EZ</b>
il, elle, on = <b>A</b>	ils, elles = <b>ONT</b>

je parlerai = I will speak

tu parleras = you will speak

il parlera = he will speak, elle parlera = she will speak, on parlera = one will speak

nous parlerons = we will speaking

vous parlerez = you will speaking

ils/elles parleront = they will speaking

The follow verbs use an irregular stem instead of the infinitive:

<b>Verb</b>	<b>Irregular Stem</b>
aller	<b>ir-</b>
avoir	<b>aur-</b>
devoir	<b>devr-</b>
envoyer	<b>enverr-</b>
être	<b>ser-</b>
faire	<b>fer-</b>
falloir	<b>faudr-</b>
mourir	<b>mourr-</b>
pleuvoir	<b>pleuvr-</b>
pouvoir	<b>pourr-</b>
recevoir	<b>recevr-</b>
savoir	<b>saur-</b>
venir	<b>viendr-</b>
voir	<b>verr-</b>
vouloir	<b>voudr-</b>
