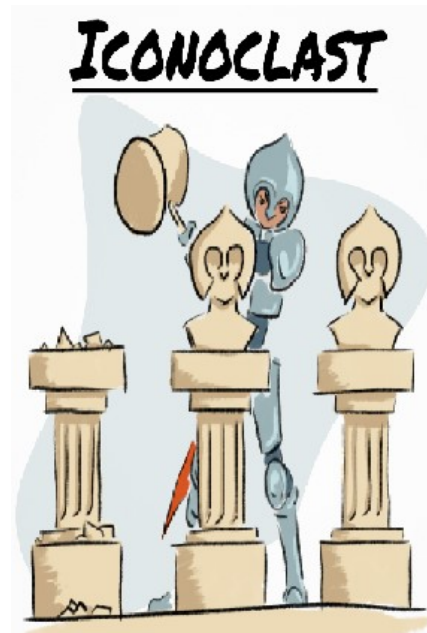

(adj.) given to intense or excessive devotion to something

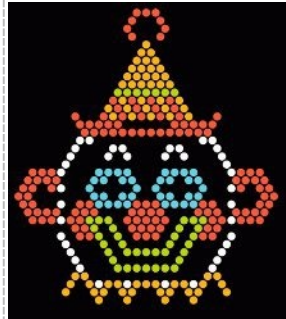
