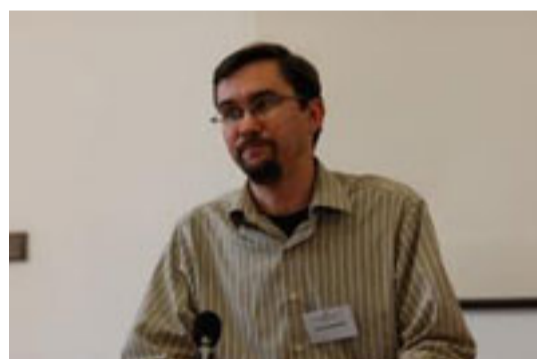
Filipe Gracioli (20 May-20 June, 2013)

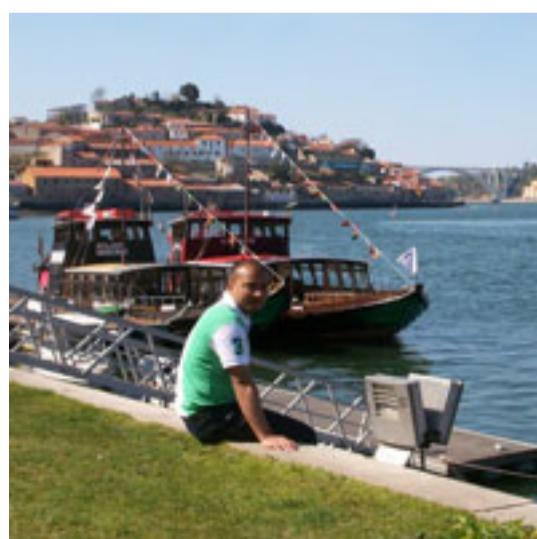
Charles Sabatos (4-29 November, 2012)
