

#### ABOUT 5 YEARS LL.B.

This is because the course gives security of career right after 12th standard on the same lines as engineering and medicine. National Law Universities (NLU) are emerging to be the most sought-after institutions in the country.

5 years law program is a mixture of classroom study, moot court competitions, internships with lawyers and law firms for practical experience and actual visits to courts and prisons. This brings the student in touch with various aspects of legal process and prepare them practically for their career. - All India Law Entrance Test (AILET) for admission to National Law University, Delhi which conducts its separate exam.
- 3. Common Entrance Test (CET) conducted by Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University for admission to University School of Law and Legal Studies and other affiliated colleges.
- 4. Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET) for entry to Symbiosis Law College, Pune, Noida and Hyderabad.
- 5. Maharashtra CET which is a standardized test adopted as an admission criterion by multiple law colleges across Maharashtra.



#### **CLAT**

Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) is a centralized test for admission to prominent National Law Universities in India. The test is taken after the higher secondary examination or the 12th grade for admission to integrated under graduation programs in Law and after graduation in law for Master of Laws (LL.M) programs conducted by these law universities. This test was conducted for the first time on 11 May 2008 by NLSIU-Bangalore. Today, it has become one of the most prestigious examination in the country on the same lines as medicine and engineering. In 2016, nearly 50000 candidates appeared vying for 1660 seats. This shows that just to get through, a student has to beat around 40 student and to get admitted to the top college, this number goes up to 100. The number of applicants is increasing manifold each year as once a student gets admitted to NLU, his/her bright career becomes guaranteed!




## **FACULTY OF LAW, DELHI UNIVERSITY**

#### SEMESTER COACHING



Any subject would include a minimum of 10 topical tests which could go up to 30 in case of bigger subjects.
- 2. Subject wise test Once a subject is complete, 4 tests of that subject are given to ensure full command upon that subject. Having already given test of all individual topics, full subject test make a student thoroughly confident upon that area.
- 3. Full syllabus Test Once the entire syllabus of semester is done, then would start the full test. This is the ultimate confidence booster instrument which helps students to study the syllabus in its entirety and give tests upon the same. This can be termed as a rehearsal of the final show and completely prepares them for the semester exam. Also, it takes away the anxiety and fear attached with the examination and makes students relaxed and confident helping them ace their exams. This also considerably improves their answer writing skills thus, paving way for the higher competition.
