

Prepositions:

A **preposition** is a word used to link nouns, pronouns, or phrases to other words within a sentence. They act to connect the people, objects, time and locations of a sentence.

Prepositions are usually short words, and they are normally placed directly in front of nouns.

Examples of Prepositions:

A **preposition** is a word which expresses relationship of a noun or a pronoun to other words of the sentence. e.g. 'in, of, to, at, by, **for**, with, under, above, into, onto, upon, about, behind, beside, before, after, towards, inside, outside, below, around' are commonly used examples of **prepositions**
