



VOCABULARY

Ebullient (adjective)

Meaning- cheerful and full of enthusiasm

Example- My brother's ebullient attitude made him favorite in the class.

Synonyms- Effervescent , exuberance peppy

Antonyms- Depressed , disinterested , serious

Drenched(verb)

Meaning- wet thoroughly , soak

Example- We were drenched by the rain .

Synonyms- Bedraggled , douse(immerse in water) , saturate

Antonyms- dehydrate, desiccate, dry

Ecstatic(adjective)

Meaning – feeling or expressing overwhelming happiness or joyful excitement .

Example- They were ecstatic about their new baby .

Synonyms- elated , euphoria, overjoy

Antonyms- miserable , unhappy ,indifferent

Enthral (Verb)

Meaning- keep someones's interest and attention completely.

Example- I was completely enthralled by her beauty .

Synonyms- charm , delight, Fascinate

Antonyms- dull , bore, repel
