

Ebullient (adjective)

Meaning-cheerful and full of enthusiam

Example-My brother's ebullient attitude made him favorite in the class.

Synonyms- Effervescent, exuberance peppy

Antonyms-Depressed, disinterested, serious

Drenched(verb)

Meaning-wet thoroughly, soak

Example-We were drenched by the rain.

Synonyms-Bedraggled, douse(immerseinwater), saturate

Antonyms-dehydrate, desiccate, dry

Ecstatic (adjective)

Meaning – feeling or expressing overwhelming happiness or joyful excitement.

Example-They were ecstatic about their new baby.

Synonyms-elated, euphoria, overjoy

Antonyms-miserable, unhappy, indifferent

Enthrall (Verb)

Meaning-keep someones's interest and attention completely.

Example- I was completely enthralled by her beauty.

Synonyms-charm, delight, Fascinate

Antonyms-dull, bore, repel
