- The minimum number of marks required to pass shall be as under :
 - For all subjects excluding Science subjects 33% in each subject
 - For Science subjects including Domestic Economy
 - 33% in written papers;
 - 25% in practical ; and
 - 33% in the aggregate of written and practical.
- First Division-540 marks or more ;
Second Division-from 405 to 539 marks
Third Division-below 405 marks.
