DETAILED ANALYSIS OF THE ESSAY:-

TA/TR-Ideas are mostly relevant but lack support points. You write unsupported claims in your writing.

CC-Problem in punctuation of proper nouns and a major error pattern is comma omission.

Paragraphing is apt.

The use of cohesive devices is satisfactory but not to the mark.

Most sentences are coherent but you should use complex sentence types to form a coherent paragraph.

LR-You have made an incorrect use of vocabulary (word forms) in several places.

Learn word conversion-from noun to verb and vice-versa.

Topic-specific vocabulary does not appeal the reader too much.

GRA-Subject verb agreement (use of s/es) is and has been a major error pattern.

Omission of articles is another type of mistake which you usually tend to make.

S.V Agreement issue but it is not your error pattern.

Improper construction of passive voice sentence.

OVERALL SUGGESTED FEEDBACK FOR IMPROVEMENT:

1. Always support your ideas and never miss writing your thesis-statement.
2. Don't miss comma after use of a connector.
3. Learn word-conversion
4. Use s/es carefully in sentences

Mis-conceptions pertaining to checking include that Task 1 gets 30% weightage whereas Task 2 gets 70% weightage in the actual test.
