

### What is an Aptitude?


An Aptitude is a component of a competency to do a certain kind of work at a certain level, which can also be considered "Talent". Every individual is unique and is born with certain inherent potential or talent. This talent helps them learn things easily and quickly. Psychologists call this potential as Aptitude.

Aptitude gets reflected in an individual, essentially as a result of early exposure during childhood and growing up years. Each one of us does several tasks or study different subjects or interacts with different people or works in different environment. # **Abstract Reasoning**



### Meaning

It measures your ability to identify the underlying logic of a pattern and then determine the solution. Abstract reasoning ability is believed to be the best indicator of fluid intelligence and your ability to learn new things quickly. Questions related to abstract reasoning appear in most technical aptitude tests.

### **Application**

Every subject requires you to co-relate and interpret theories and other concepts. After reading any information, you start analyzing and co-relating the data. Example: Reading and gravitational pull and reasoning why people fall only towards earth!

### **Improvement**

You can enhance this ability by reading small passages and concluding the information gathered. Start enjoying questions like when, why, who, what, how etc.

# **Numeric Ability**



### Meaning

It includes basic arithmetic, number sequence and simple mathematics. These questions appear in most technical aptitude tests because employers usually want some indication of your ability to use numbers even if this is not a major part of the job.

### **Application**

Numerical ability is essential to organize numerical data for simple calculations. In academics, problems solving and precise measurements are required. Example: Finding out the area of a circle, solving SUDOKU etc. reflects numerical ability.

### **Improvement**

It can be improved by understanding concepts in mathematics. You may refer scholarship Mathematics to sharpen the concepts. You can go through the concepts of primary standards and try to solve them across the chapters.

# **Verbal Ability**



### Meaning

# **Spatial Ability**



### Meaning

The ability to interpret and make drawings, form mental images, visualize movements or change in those images. Spatial ability tests measure your ability to manipulate shapes in 2D or to visualize 3 D objects presented as two dimensional pictures. Spatial ability tests often involve the visual assembly and the disassembly of objects that have been rotated or which are viewed from different angles or objects that have different markings on their surfaces.

### **Application**

It is necessary in day - to - day life to make a judgment about space with respect to length, width, depth, distance, speed etc. This ability is necessary for all sorts of academics in which understanding and use of 2-D and 3-D is required. Example: If you are standing in front of a big mall, what can be probable height, width and depth in feet?


### **Improvement**

A Perceiving (P) style takes the outside world AS IT COMES and is adopting and adapting, flexible, open-ended and receptive to new opportunities and changing game plans.


