

MS-Excel Shortcuts

Ctrl + Space bar	Select the entire column
Shift + Space bar	Select the entire row
Shift + Ctrl + Space bar	Select current data region / table
Ctrl + A	Select entire region
Shift + Home	Select entire range to left from active cell
Shift + End + Arrow Key (up, down, right, left)	Select range from current cell to end in arrow direction
Ctrl + *	Select continues range from active cell
F5 + ALT + S + K + Enter	Select blank cells
Ctrl + Shift + O	Select all cells with comments
Ctrl + Shift + {	Select all cells that are directly or indirectly referred in the selected formula
Ctrl + Shift + }	Select all cells with formulas that referred current cell directly or indirectly
Ctrl + Shift + Home	Select all cells from current cells towards A1
Ctrl + Shift + Arrow	Select cells in the direct of arrow
Ctrl + Page + Up	Previous Sheet
Ctrl + Page + Down	Next Sheet
F5	Launch GOTO dialog box
Ctrl + Home	Go to top left (top left of freeze pane, if set)
Ctrl + end	Go to last non-blank cell
Ctrl + p	Print
Ctrl + Tab	Toggle between open (more than 1) workbooks (in a session of MS-Excel)
F4	Change the type of cell reference (in formula bar)
F4	Repeat the last action (in worksheet)
F9	Debug/evaluate portion of formula (in formula bar)
ALT + =	Sum range
Ctrl + Shift + Enter	Enter Array Function
Ctrl + /	Select array function
F3	Display name range (can be use while typing functions)
ALT + TUF	Function Evaluate window
Ctrl + ‘	Copy formula from above cell in edit mode
Ctrl + A	Display function argument window (pressed when typing a function)
