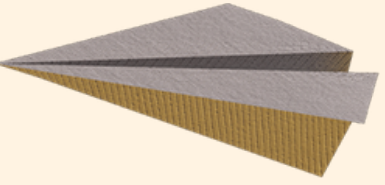




WHAT IS A 'GREETING'?

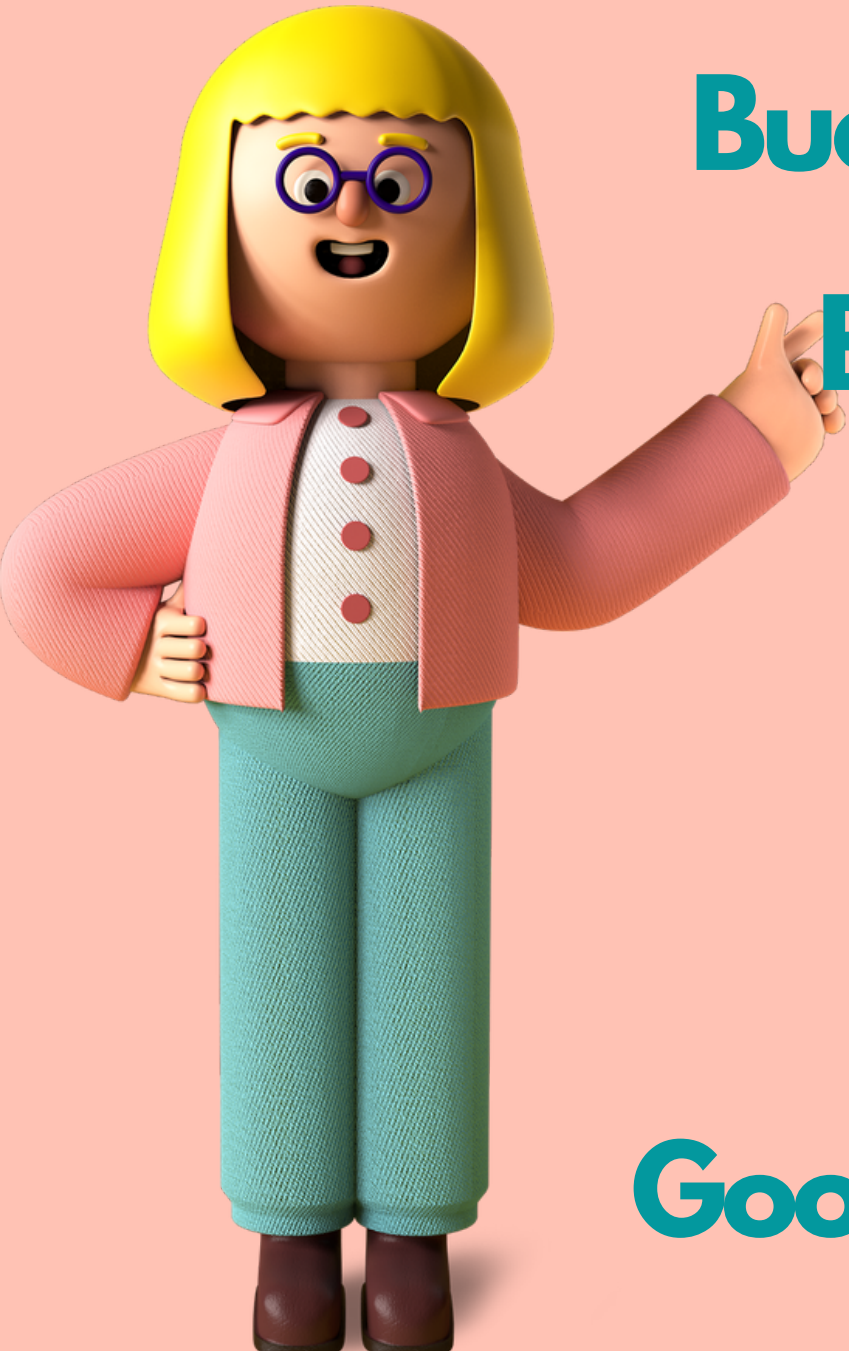
Buenos días señora

In Spanish, it is totally acceptable to call someone by titles without the name.

In English, would not be said. The title would not be used without the person's name.

Can be used formal and informal conversations.

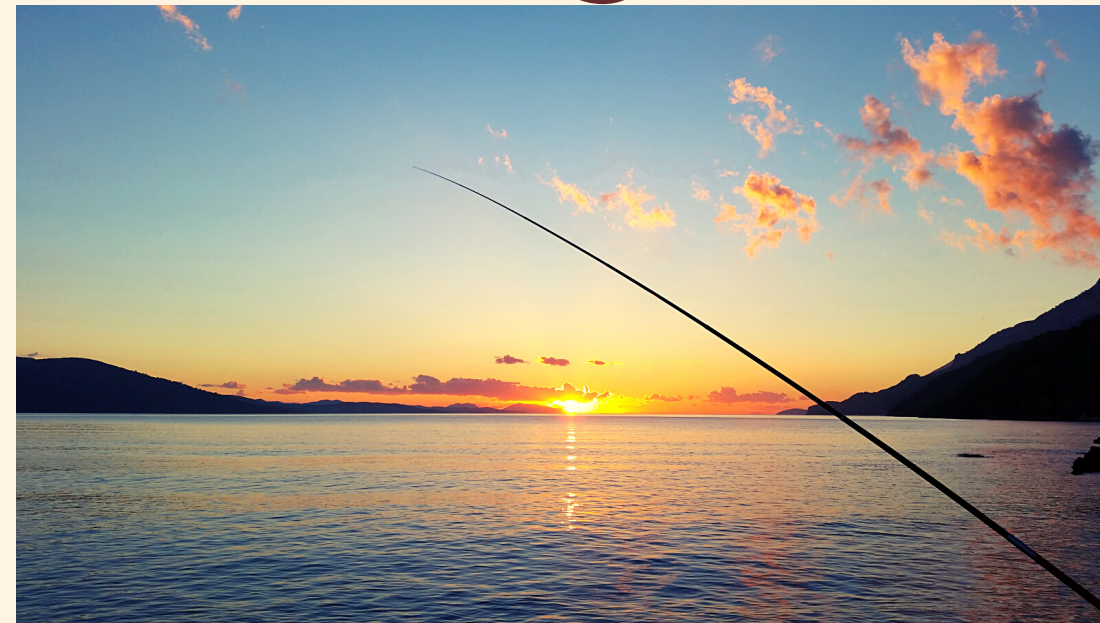


Buenos días - Good morning

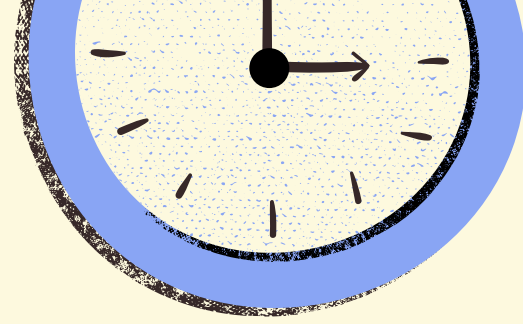
