

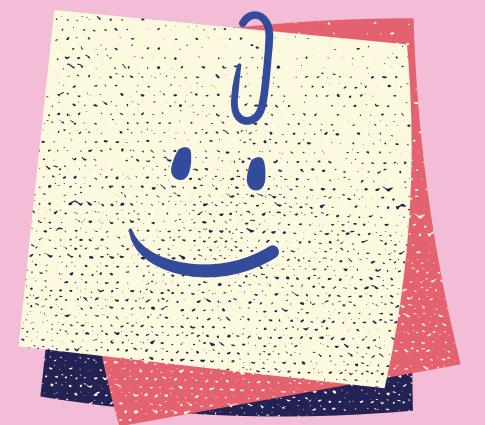

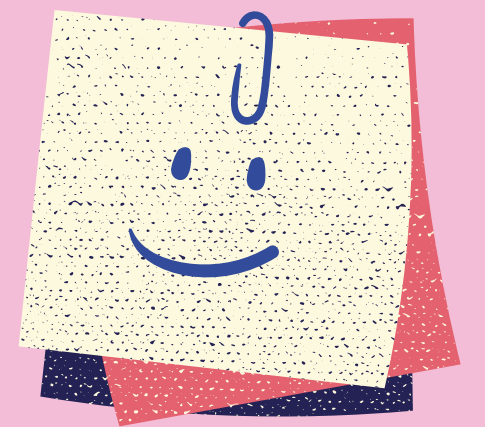

Politics, Administration, Education, Judiciary, Land Taxes, Trade, Agriculture

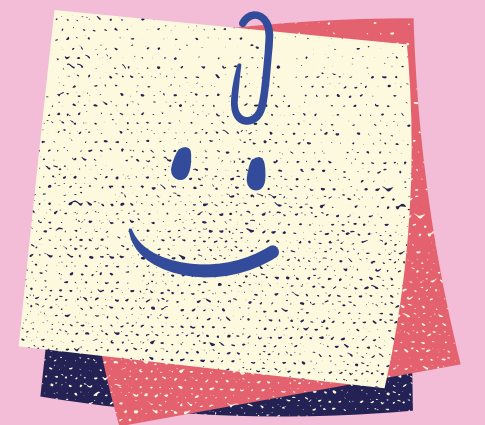


The Impact of British Rule in India

(criminal court**

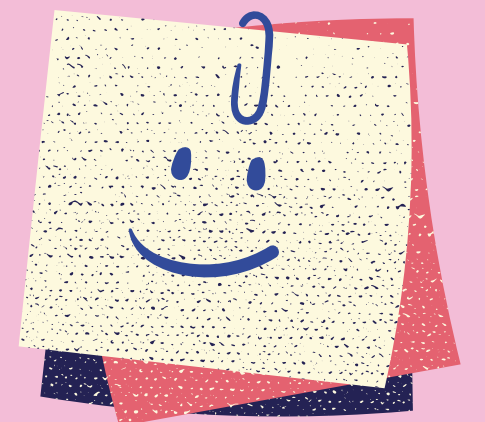


The Impact of British Rule in India

Police system

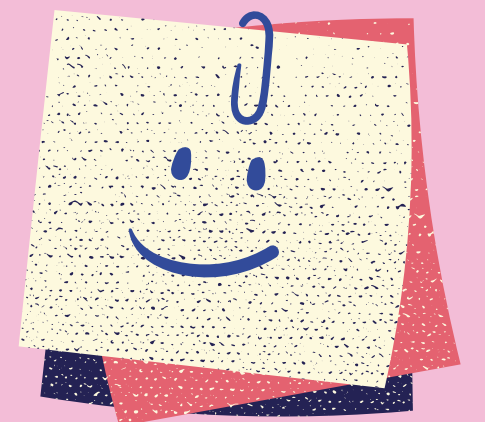
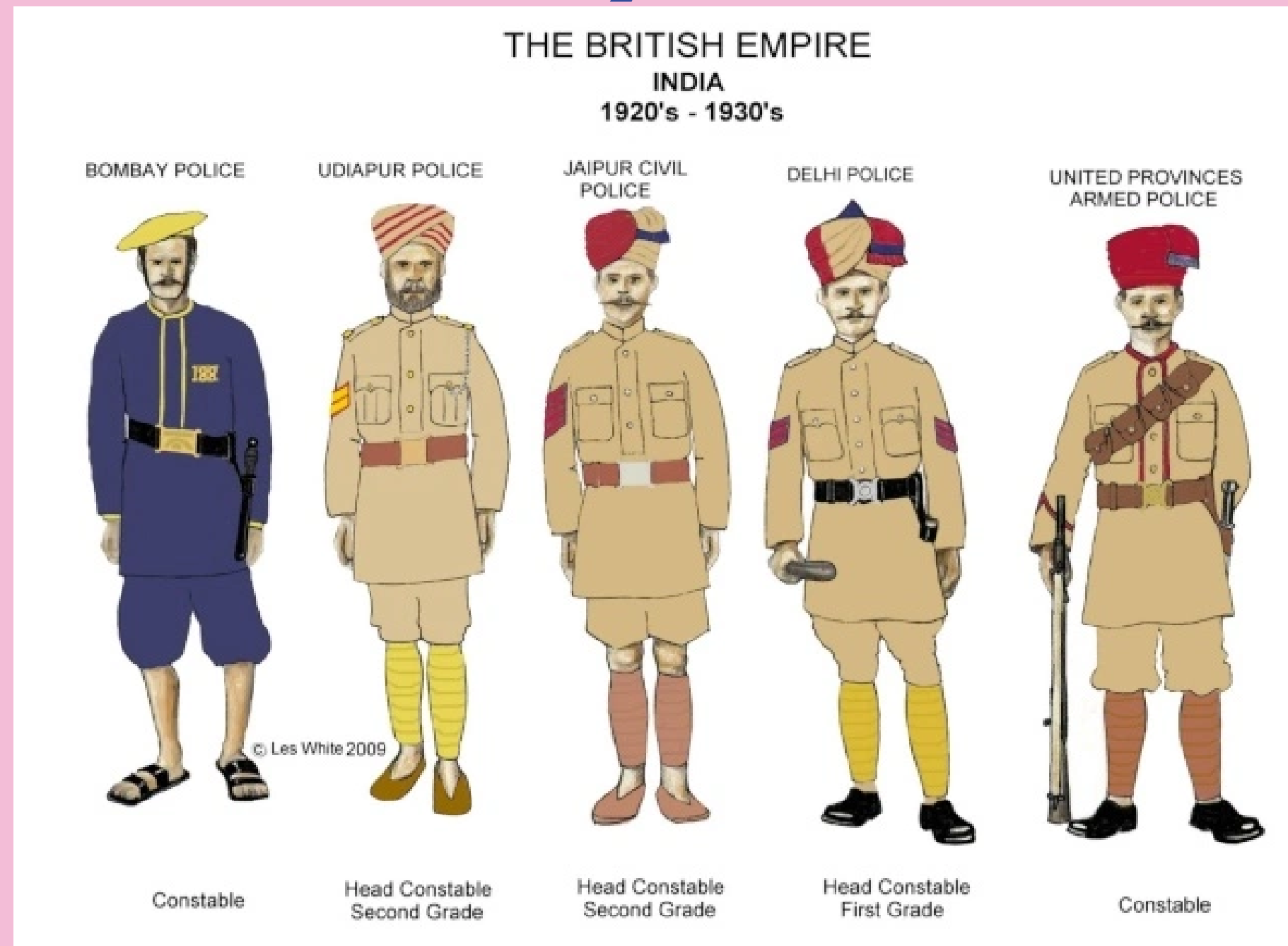
In charge of internal law and order.

Police system

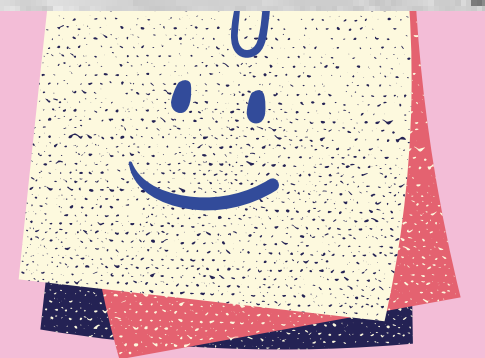


The Impact of British Rule in India

Officers were Britishers and Soliders were Indians

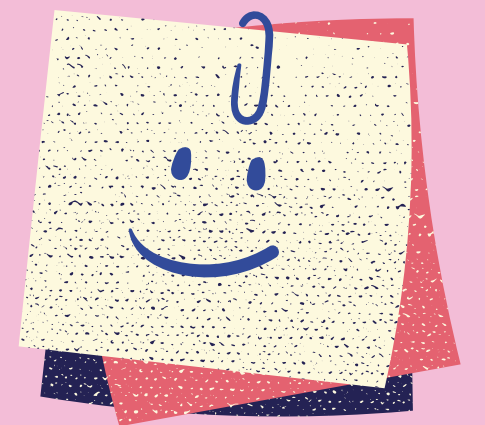


The Impact of British Rule in India

Warren Hastings facilitated the expansion of Modern education in India

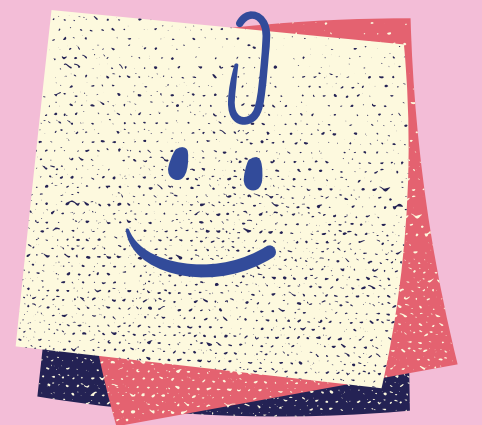


The Impact of British Rule in India

opinion and taste".**

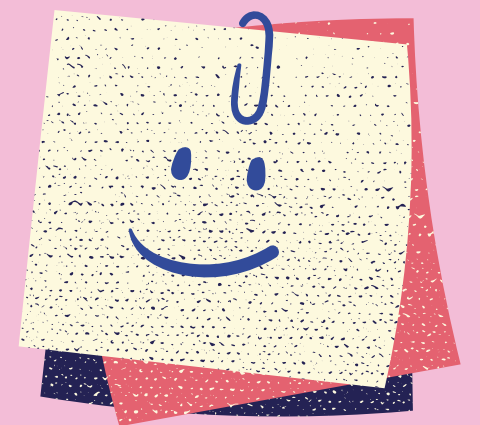


The Impact of British Rule in India

Impact:

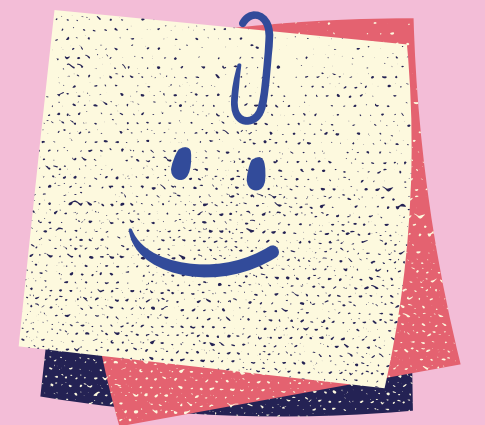
- **Indians could develop modernity, democratic attitude**
- **Impetus received for local literature and languages.**
- **Periodicals started emerging.**



The Impact of British Rule in India

Foundation of British education

- British planned to educate a small section of upper and middle classes to create a class “Indian in blood and colour but English in taste.”
- Producing civil servants
- Christian Missionaries : wanted to promote Western Education because they thought that modern education would destroy the faith of the Indians for the own religions
