## CONJUGATION OF IRREGULAR VERBS; Present Tense ending in `ir'

Though we have regular verbs ending in `ir' like `finir', `choisir', `remplir' we have a few verbs ending in `ir' which are irregular.

(Just to recollect what you have learnt, the regular verbs ending in `ir' have the endings `is, is, it, issons, issez ,issent)

Though the following verbs end in `ir' they are conjugated with endings just like regular `er' verbs.

(Just to recollect the endings for regular verbs ending in `er' are e, es, e, ons, ez, ent)
