Paper 5 :Speaking Endorsement

In syllabus 0510, marks for the Speaking component do not contribute to the overall grade candidates receive or the written components. Instead, where candidates perform to an appropriate standard, certificates record separately the achievements of candidates, with grades **1 (high) to 5 (low) for speaking.**
