- **Backlash(प्रतिक्रिया)** a strong negative reaction by a large number of people, especially to a social or political development

“The government is facing an angry **backlash** from voters over the new tax.”

- **Wallow(लोट-पोट)** of a person) indulge in an unrestrained way in (something that one finds pleasurable).

“This is a time when you will be vulnerable, so let yourself feel the emotions, but don't **wallow** in them”

- **Revere(सम्मान)** feel deep respect or admiration for (something)

“Conner reveres his older brother Tyler, so he tries to copy everything he does”

- **Bask(आनंद उठाना)** lie exposed to warmth and light, typically from the sun, for relaxation and pleasure
revel in and make the most of (something pleasing)

“Before the actor can bask in the admiration of his fans, he must take questions from the media.”

▪ **Inundate(प्लावित करना)-**

overwhelm (someone) with things or people to be dealt with.

“We've been **inundated** with complaints from listeners”
