10 basic lessons

10 Grammar Lessons

20 conversational exercises

## **Basic 10 lessons consist of topics like**

Greetings and introduction

A and an

Citrus fruits

Plural nouns , general vocabulary , everyday activities, verbs ending with ING ,how to apologize....etc

## **10 Grammar lesson**

Verbs, adjectives, adverbs, preposition, tenses, conjunctions.

## **20 conversational exercises**

Supermarket shopping English lesson

Salon - hairdressers learning English at the salon

Emotion happy and Feeling Good

English lesson about Emotion and talking to someone is angry

Halloween conversation between 4 people discussing going trick or treating on Halloween

Conversation about going a speech on global warming....etc

Speeches, writing emails, story writing

# Lesson plan advance – 40 classes

It will consist of 3 categories

2. English Grammar-10 classes
3. Conversational Exercises - 20 classes

Topics covered in each lesson

## **Basic lessons**

Everyday activities, formal greetings, telephone phrasal verbs, small talk English conversation

Directions, booking a taxi, use of (a, an, the, so, that, who, too), greetings and introduction,

Confirming your flight, expressing opinion, food adjectives, health and family, idioms, (there, their and they usage), weather asking questions, contractions. etc.

## **Grammar**

Nouns, pronouns, adjectives, verbs, adverbs, determiners, conjunctions, tenses, prepositions, Compound words.

## **Conversational exercises**

Asking for help, business greeting visitors, negotiations, talking to workers, at the airport conversation, credit cards, making a hotel booking, shopping and shops, ...etc
