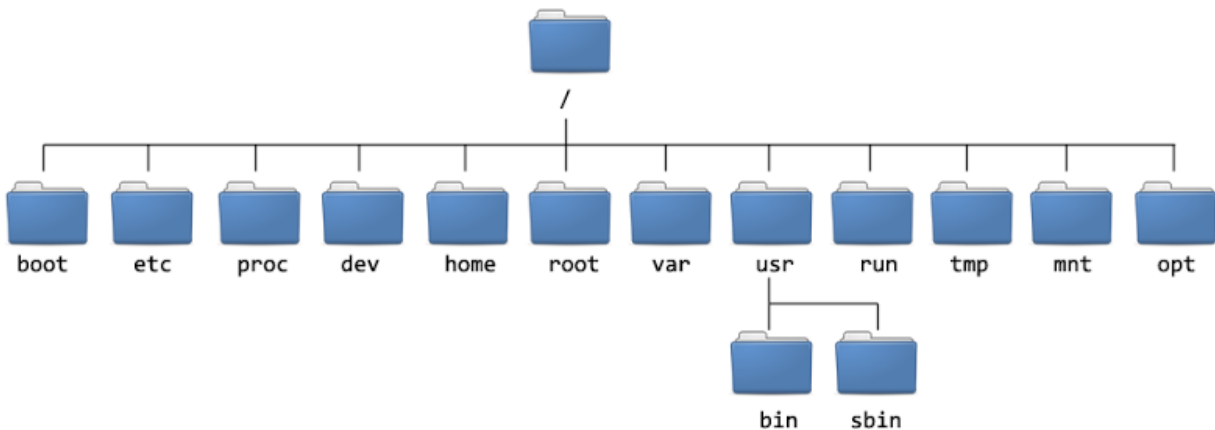


## Linux File system:

### CentOS 7 Filesystem Hierarchy



Right click on Desktop and click open interterminal

### Login to Linux system and run simple commands

Check present Working Directory:

```
$pwd
```

```
/home/cloudera/Desktop
```

Change Directory:

```
$cd /home/cloudera
```

Clear the screen

```
$clear
```

Change to one previous directory

```
$cd ..
```

```
$pwd
```

```
/home
```

```
$cd /home/cloudera/Desktop
```

```
Change to two previous directory
```

```
$cd ../../
```

```
$pwd
```

```
/home
```

## Create, view and edit text files:

```
vim
```

```
touch
```

```
gedit
```

```
vim (create single file)
```

When the file is created it is in command mode to get into insert mode press i, and then enter the text, to save the file get back to command mode and press :wq!

```
$ vim test
```

```
insert the text
```

```
press esc
```

```
:wq! ( to exit )
```

## Create and Edit text files with vim Editor:(IN DETAIL)

### Insert mode(press any one to get into insert mode):

i - Insert before cursor

I - Insert in the beginning of the line

a - Append character after the cursor

A - Append the character at the end of line

o - Add blank line below the cursor

O - Add blank line above the cursor

R - switch to replace mode
