Lesson outline:

Introduction: Welcome students to the class and explain that this lesson will allow them to get to know and find out more about their classmates.

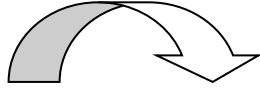

<i>How are you?</i>	<i>Fine, thanks. And you?</i>
<i>How have you been?</i>	<i>Very well. And you?</i>
<i>How are things?</i>	<i>Not too bad, thanks</i>
<i>How is your girlfriend?</i>	<i>She's fine.</i>

Formal greetings and responses

Formal Greetings	Responses
- Good morning.	- Hello.
- Good afternoon.	- Hello, good afternoon.
- Good evening.	- Good evening.
- Hello, how are you?	- I'm fine. Thank you.
	- Very well, thank you.



<i>Hello John, How are you?</i>	<i>Hi, Kelly! I'm fine thanks!</i>
<i>How are you?</i>	<i>Great, thank you!</i>
<i>How are you?</i>	<i>I'm Very Well thank you</i>
<i>How are you?</i>	<i>Not too bad, thanks</i>
<i>How are you?</i>	<i>Not very well, thanks</i>



Activity:

- *Get the group to make two circles in the following manner:*
- *Give alternate numbers 1 and 2 to each participant.*
- *All the number 1s make a circle here. Now ask the 2s to make another circle.*
- *Give the group a soft rubber ball and demonstrate the activity as shown below.*
- *Start by saying: 'We are going to introduce ourselves by playing 'catch the ball'*
- *Say your name and throw the ball to a participant.*
- *Tell her /him.*
- *Now you say your name and throw it to someone else.*
